Notice and Take Down Procedure

Web Site Usage Policy

Anyone using an authlogics website (“User”) shall be subject to this Notice and Takedown Procedure.

1. Undesirable Content and behavior

- 1.1. Authlogics respects the intellectual property rights of others and is committed to helping third parties protect their rights. We prohibit users from posting content that violates another party's intellectual property rights. When we receive a valid notice of IP infringement, we shall promptly remove or disable access to the allegedly infringing content. We also terminate the accounts of repeat infringers in appropriate circumstances. All Users must comply with applicable copyright laws when publishing content or linking to content on another site (“User Content”).

- 1.2. While Authlogics respects and encourages the constitutional right to freedom of speech and expression, in the interest of all Users the following content is regarded undesirable. (This prohibition applies regardless of whether you are posting content created by someone else.):
 - Content that is, or can generally be considered, or is in Authlogics’s sole discretion, obscene, sexually
 - explicit or pornographic;
 - Content that is illegal or unlawful;
 - Content that you know to be false, or is designed to be misleading;
 - Content that is defamatory, intimidating, harassing, hateful, injurious, racist, sexist, abusive, malicious or threatening to any person or group of persons;
 - Content that incites hatred or violence;
 - Content that infringes or may infringe the intellectual property rights of any person or legal entity. This includes content that you didn’t create or which you do not have permission to post;
 - Content that constitutes or may constitute an invasion of the privacy rights of any person;
 - Content that constitutes, or may constitute, the wrongful or unlawful disclosure or publication of confidential information or trade secrets;
 - Content that is otherwise injurious to any person;
 - Content that may expose Authlogics or any other users to harm or liability of any type.

The following conduct is prohibited (whether for yourself or on behalf of any other person):

- Impersonate any person or your affiliation with any person;
- Harass or intimidate any person;
- Collect the personal information of any person;
- Post spam;
- Any action that may expose Authlogics or any other users to any harm or liability of any type.



2. Notice of Alleged Infringement

If you believe that your copyrighted work or other intellectual property right has been infringed, or you wish to report undesirable content or behavior please provide Authlogics's Designated Agent the following information in a **WRITTEN COMMUNICATION**:

- the full names and address of the complainant;
- the written or electronic signature of the complainant;
- identification of the right that has allegedly been infringed;
- identification of the material or activity that is claimed to be the subject of unlawful activity;
- the remedial action required to be taken by Authlogics in respect of the complaint;
- telephonic and electronic contact details, if any, of the complainant;
- a statement that the complainant is acting in good faith eg: "I have a good faith belief that use of the material in the manner complained of is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law";
- a statement by the complainant that the information in the take-down notification is to his or her knowledge true and correct.

If Authlogics receives proper notice of copyright infringement, as set forth above ("Notice of Alleged Infringement"), we will remove or disable access to such allegedly infringing User Content. Any person who lodges a notification of unlawful activity with Authlogics knowing that it materially misrepresents the facts is liable for damages (including costs and attorney's fees) for wrongful takedown.

3. Reporting Abuse

AUTHLOGICS DOES NOT SPECIFICALLY MONITOR CONTENT POSTED ON THE WEBSITE. IF YOU COME ACROSS ANY CONTENT POSTED ON THE WEBSITE THAT IS UNDESIRABLE AND/OR MEETS THE CRITERIA OF PROHIBITED CONTENT REFERRED TO IN CLAUSE 1 ABOVE, YOU ARE OBLIGED TO REPORT IT TO AUTHLOGICS, AT THE ADDRESS PROVIDED IN CLAUSE 4 BELOW. Please keep in mind that reporting a piece of content does not guarantee that it will be removed from the Website. Because of the diversity of our community, it's possible that something could be disagreeable or disturbing to you without meeting the criteria for being removed or blocked. Complaints that are frivolous, unreasonable, vexatious or in bad faith will not be entertained. While we will make all reasonable efforts to investigate and resolve any complaints, Authlogics has no obligation, to monitor or become involved in disputes.
