# Privacy Policy

**Web Site Usage Policy**

## 1. Introduction

- 1.1. Authlogics Ltd (hereinafter referred to 'us', 'we' or 'Authlogics') is committed to protecting and respecting the individual's right to privacy. Our privacy policy reflects current global principles and standards on handling personal data.
- 1.2. This policy (together with our terms of use and any other documents referred to on it) sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from the user of Authlogics' worldwide websites (hereinafter referred to 'you'), or that you provide to us, will be processed by us.
- 1.3. This privacy policy applies to all Authlogics websites and our affiliates' websites (if any). This privacy policy does not apply to services offered by third party companies or individuals such as but not limited to sites linked from our services, advertiser's services or other companies referred to in our site.

## 2. Personal data Authlogics may collect from you

- 2.1. Authlogics may collect and process personal data (information) that you provide us in any of the following ways:
  - 2.1.1. Information that you provide by filling in forms on any of our sites as listed in the attached document ('our site'). This includes information provided at the time of registering to use our site, subscribing to our service, posting material, any inquiry through the "Contact Us" section of the Site, an online employment application or requesting further services. We may also ask you for information when you report a problem with our site.
  - 2.1.2. If you contact us for any purpose whatsoever, we may keep a record of that correspondence.
  - 2.1.3. Authlogics may also ask you to complete surveys that we use for research purposes, although you do not have to respond to them.
  - 2.1.4. Details of your visits to our site including, but not limited to, traffic data, country data based on the IP address, weblogs and other communication data, and the resources that you access.
  - 2.1.5. Persons who supply us with their phone numbers, mailing address, phone number, and email address online may receive telephone contact or an answer in the form of an answer to an email or documentation sent to an address with information regarding new products and services or upcoming events. If you do not wish to receive such telephone calls or any other form of answer, please let us know by sending us an email.
- 2.2. Authlogics may collect and process personal data (information) that we collect from you in any of the following ways:
  - 2.2.1. IP ADDRESSES

We may collect information about your computer that does not, by itself, identify you by name, including where available your IP address, operating system and browser type, for system administration and to report aggregate information to our advertisers. This is statistical data about our users' browsing actions and patterns. The purpose of



the data is to improve effectiveness of the site, to help diagnose problems and to administer the site.

#### 2.2.2.COOKIES

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site.

#### 2.2.3.INFORMATION GATHERING TOOLS

Authlogics may also collect information during your visit to our website through automated tools, which include Web beacons (or named as web bugs), embedded web links and any other commonly used information gathering tools.

- 2.2.3.1. A web bug is an object that is embedded in a web page or email and is usually invisible to the user but allows checking that a user has viewed the page or email. Authlogics may use the Web beacons for the purpose of email tracking and page tagging for Web analytics. In addition, we might use web bugs implemented through an embedded image include tracking pixel, pixel tag, 1x1 gif, and clear gif that may be implemented by using JavaScript.

### 3. Where we store your personal data

- 3.1. The data that we collect from you may be processed, transferred to, and stored at any destination in the world located outside of the country where the data is collected. This means that data protection standards may be different from the place where the data is collected (such as a destination outside the European Economic Area ("EEA"), a destination outside the USA, or any other destination in the world). Data may be also stored in a cloud service and therefore located in an unknown place in the world. Data may also be processed by staff, operating outside any other countries where the data is collected, who work for us as an employee or contractor or for one of our third party suppliers (i.e. agents, service vendors, business partner and other). Such staff maybe engaged in, among other things, the fulfilment of your request and the provision of any kind of support services. By submitting your personal data to us, you agree to this transfer, storing or processing at any location in the world. Authlogics will take reasonable steps necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this privacy policy.
- 3.2. Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password which enables you to access certain parts of our site, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. We ask you not to share a password with anyone.

### 4. Uses made and purpose of the personal data

- 4.1. We use personal data collected and held about you through this website in the following ways:
  - 4.1.1.To ensure that content of our site is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer.



- 4.1.2. To respond to your requests and thereafter to process your requests and deliver the requested materials and information. Any personal data requested by us will be the minimum to enable Authlogics to deal with the request. Where additional information is requested this will be marked and its provision is voluntary.
- 4.1.3. To provide you with information, products or services which we feel may be of an interest to you, where you have consented to be contacted for such purposes. Upon your acceptance, we may contact you via your email, telephone or address provided. The purpose of the data collected is to keep you up to date on the latest product announcements and services for marketing purposes or promotional activities and to respond to any of your requests. In addition, in case of a job application, the information will be kept in order to be able to respond back to you.
- 4.1.4. To notify you about changes to our service.
- 4.1.5. If you would not wish us to contact you (via phone, email, SMS or any other way), nor use your data in the way described in this privacy policy, nor you would want us to pass your details on to third parties, please do not hesitate to contact us at the following email address: [info@authlogics.com](mailto:info@authlogics.com)
- 4.1.6. Sensitive information is not sought through this website except where legally required or for legitimate purpose. However, if you decide to provide such sensitive information, the information will be accepted as explicit consent to use that information in connection with the purpose for which it has been provided.

## 5. Sharing of your personal data

- 5.1. As a global business operating company, we may disclose your personal data to any member of Authlogics group of companies, which means our subsidiaries located at any place in the world.
- 5.2. We may disclose your personal data to third parties in the following cases:
  - 5.2.1. In the event that we sell, buy, merger, consolidate, transfer, change in control any business or assets, in which case we may disclose your personal data to the prospective seller or buyer of such business or assets.
  - 5.2.2. In the event of reorganisation or liquidation of our company whereby in some countries such a transaction may involve, in accordance with applicable laws, the disclosure of personal data to prospective or actual purchasers, or the receipt of it from sellers.
  - 5.2.3. If we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal or regulatory obligation or any other governmental request.
  - 5.2.4. If we may be required to provide personal data in response to a court order, subpoena, warrant, government investigation, any procedure issued by authority, or as otherwise required by law. We also may choose to establish or exercise our legal rights or defend against legal claims.
  - 5.2.5. If we believe that there is a threat to the information stored in this website, or in order to protect or defend our rights or the well-being of our users. In general, we may release certain personal data in cases where we believe that the release of the



information is reasonably necessary to protect the rights, property, and safety of others and ourselves.

- 5.2.6. We may contract with any third party supplier to provide any services for operating this website, for any requests or for the purpose of supporting our business activities. Any third party providing services to us may be allowed, on our behalf, to access your personal data provided by you for their proper use in connection with the specific services provided.
- 5.2.7. In cases where you provide us with your consent to do so. In those cases, we will ask you for an explicit written consent confirmation.

## 6. Your rights on how the personal data is used

- 6.1. You have the right to ask us not to process your personal data in general or for any specific purpose. We will usually inform you (before collecting your data) if we intend to use your data for such purposes or if we intend to disclose your information to any third party for such purposes. You can exercise your right to prevent such processing at any time by contacting us at [info@authlogics.com](mailto:info@authlogics.com). Your opt-out right will only apply for the specific purpose you have asked us for and therefore we may choose to correspond with you regarding your existing requests or other matters with us or to any correspondence that has already been initiated.
